Requirements

All Levels of Scouts Make at least one visit to the Second Saturday Program (offered on select Saturdays of each month)

Tigers Do at least **one** activity in **three** of the four areas

Cubs and Webelos Do at least **two** activities in **three** of the four areas

Boy Scouts Do at least **two** activities in **each** area listed below

Note: Requirements are to be approved by parent or leader.

Area 1 Living History Farm

- Visit the one-room, Old Rector School and take in a lesson.
- Stop in the farmhouse main room to learn about toys of long ago.
- Stop in the farmhouse kitchen and learn about cooking a meal over a fire.
- Do the seasonal activity that takes place on the month of your visit.

Area 2 Harrison Hall of Natural Science

- Visit the Discovery Room to learn about two (2) amphibians and three (3) types of reptiles using the cage ID cards.
- Visit the Marine Lab to learn about five (5) marine creatures and their adaptations.
- Visit the Ecology Lab to learn about five (5) Habitats of South Carolina and search for animals painted in the mural of each.
- Visit the Symmes Tropical Rainforest to discover some tropical plants and animals.

Area 3 Symmes Hall of Science and Giant Dome Theater & Planetarium

- Attend a planetarium show.
- Visit the Observatory to view the sun and learn how the large telescope works.
- Take in the auditorium show of the month at the F.W. Symmes Hall of Science.
- Visit a STEM Lab for an activity or display.

Area 4 Other Areas of the Center

- Visit the Butterfly Garden and learn about the flowers that attract butterflies.
- Walk one of the nature trails.
- Visit the Arboretum.
